- Share your “Lesson Reflections” responses with the group.
- Read **John 3:16** – why is this verse so famous? When does eternal life begin?
- Read **John 3:17-21** – In your own words, summarize what John/Jesus is saying about being condemned versus not condemned. How can we keep from loving darkness? Do you have an **Ecclesiastes 4:10** brother or sister to hold you accountable? If so, describe how he/she has helped your walk.
- Read **John 3:22-30**. How is our role as disciples like John the Baptist’s role? What does this passage teach us about disputing with other believers (other Baptist believers or other non-Baptist believers)?
- Read **John 31-36**. What is the essence of what John is communicating here?
  - In verse 36, why does John say “believe” for one group but “obey” for the second group? Is there a distinction between belief and obedience?

**GO!**

**What is God saying to you, and how are you responding?**

Matthew 9:37-38 – the harvest is plentiful, but the laborers are few. Therefore, pray earnestly to the Lord of the harvest to send laborers into His harvest.

**What is something you are excited about right now?**

Psalms 37:4 Delight in the Lord, and He will give you the desires of your heart.

**What is a big challenge you are facing right now?**

Gal 6:2 Bear one another’s burdens and fulfill the Law of Christ.

**Who is on your heart right now and why?**

James 5:13 Is anyone among you suffering? Let him pray. Is anyone cheerful? Let him sing praise.

**Review the last lesson’s GO section. What prayers has God answered?**

Philippians 4:8 Whatever is true, whatever is honorable, whatever is just, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely, whatever is commendable, if there is any excellence, if there is anything worthy of praise, think about these things.
