so that we may eat!'				
Jn 6:9 - 2 Kings 4:42-44 "Now a man came from Baal-shalishah, and brought the man of God bread of the first fruits,				
twenty loaves of barley and fresh grain in his sack. And Elisha said, "Give them to the people that they may eat." But his				
attendant said, "How am I to serve this to a hundred men?" Nevertheless he said, "Give them to the people that they				
may eat, for this is what the Lord says: 'They shall eat and have some left over.' " So he served it to them, and they ate

- Share any "Lesson Reflections" with the group. Recite this lesson's Memory and In His Dust verses; discuss what they mean to you.
- John 6:1-4
 - What four details connect Jesus to Moses, and why does John want us to make this connection to Moses?
- John 6:5-14
 - Jesus is perfectly capable of delivering Manna from heaven. Why did He "test" Philip? How would you have responded if you were Philip? Andrew? One of the 5000?
 - Why does Jesus have the disciples gather the loaves? What is the lesson for those who would be His disciples today?
 - The Resurrection and the 5000 are the only miracles recorded in all four Gospels. What makes this feeding miracle so important?
 - List at least two applications to be gleaned from Jesus' feeding of the 5000.
- John 6:14-21
 - What was the problem with the crowd wanting to make Him King; isn't that why He came? In what ways are you like that crowd, and what is the remedy to avoid their error?
 - Why does Jesus walk on water to His disciples? Why not just go with them on the boat? What was He teaching in this story?
 - How does fear prevent you from seeing the Savior?
 - What is the significance of Mark's comment, "...And He intended to pass by them" (Mark 6:48)?
- Matthew 14:28-34
 - Scholars debate whether 14:28 should be translated as "since it is You...".
 How does changing the word from "if" to "since" change the complexion of the passage?
 - How much do **YOU** desire to be like Jesus, your Rabbi?
 - What keeps you from getting out of the boat?
- What do you want to remember and apply from this lesson?
- Spend the last five minutes in prayer pairs
 - Praise for answered prayers, growth, and how God is working in your life
 - Petitions for specific challenges and intercessions for others
